Like a great many residents of Byfleet I am dismayed by the idea of the development of a large part of our remaining greenspace, especially as it is within the Green Belt. I lack the legal skills to present effective arguments against the plan within the brief time allowed, and I hope that the plan is eventually dropped for one reason or another.

Meanwhile, I have a query, in the event that the development ever become a reality; has any consideration been given to what area/areas of Suitable Alternative Greenspace Area (SANG) could possibly be found in Byfleet? I stress 'Suitable', as by definition this must rule out land that is liable to flooding, or even heavy going in Winter, but must supply a genuine alternative recreational area all year round.
