Regarding: Woking 2027 DPD Consultation.

As a resident of Mayford for almost 30 years I am very concerned about the planning proposals that have been put forward for Mayford.

Site Reference: GB7 (Ten Acre Farm, Smarts Heath Road)

I strongly object to the proposal to increase the number of Traveller Pitches on this land. This would spoil the character of the area and as the adjacent Smarts Heath Common is an SSSI, an increase in the number of domestic animals would affect the wildlife.

The following site references are also of great concern:

GB10 (Land to the north east of Saunders Lane, between Saunders Lane and Hook Hill Lane)

GB11 (Land to the north west of Saunders Lane)

GB14 (Land adjacent to Hook Hill Lane)

I strongly object to the proposal for housing on all of the above sites. These are Green Belt sites and should remain Green Belt sites.

There appears to have been no consideration to the impact on Mayford's infrastructure that the increase in population will have. There are, at the present time, problems with the the volume of traffic trying to enter Woking on the A320 road from Guildford to Woking and when the school is built in Egley Road this will increase. Increasing the width of Saunders Lane will only increase the volume of traffic and increase the problems.

Please reconsider your plans which will, in their present form, have a devastating impact on Mayford as a Village.
