I have been a resident of Mayford for 30 years and have learned about the Woking 2027 planning proposals which will affect Mayford.

Site Ref. GB7 (Ten Acre Farm, Smarts Heath Road).

I object strongly to further development of this site.

Site Ref. GB8 Nursery Land adjacent to Egley Road

Site Ref. GB9 Woking Garden Centre, Egley Road

Site Ref. GB10 Land to the north-east of Saunders Lane between Saunders Lane and Hook Heath Lane

Site Ref. GB11 Land to the north-west of Saunders Lane

Site Ref. GB14 Land adjacent to Hook Hill Lane

I strongly object to the proposal for housing on all these sites.

The green belt space between Mayford and Woking would be lost and Mayford would become a suburb of Woking, and , in time, because of the precedent being set, Woking could become a northern part of Guildford.

Green Belt is such a necessary scheme in this built-up area of Britain.

At certain times of day in school term times, the roads, especially Egley Road, are extremely busy and can become gridlocked, even without this large building project taking place.

Many people use much of the land for walking, exercise recommended for health reasons, and this area would be lost.

I am also a member of the Mayford Village Society, who are better able to express my views and I would ask you to refer to the response of the Mayford Village Society.
