I wish to object to the proposal by WBC to build over 400 new houses at Upshot Lane, Pyrford.

I object for the following reasons:

Loss of Green Belt . The land is an attractive and valued feature of the area and had already been identified as inappropriate for development.

Loss of trees and views and damage to the area's landscape.

The additional houses would detract from the existing village atmosphere.

Traffic congestion would get worse and the extra road users would cause additional safety problems.

The existing infrastructure would be totally unable to accommodate the additional demands made on it

- lack of parking around the station & shops/ severe damage/ noise / nuisance to residential roads from increased parking.

Permanent gridlock in West Byfleet and Pyrford - with no opportunity to address the traffic issues

The principal reasons for existing residents moving to the area would be lost.
