I am against the proposals for future housing development in Pyrford.

Access to Parvis Road in both directions at peak travel times AM & PM is severely restricted from

all access roads in Pyrford due to congestion in Parvis Road.

Any problems on the A3 and M25 (which are frequent) result in further traffic through Pyrford thus adding to the daily congestion and frequently resulting in complete standstill "GRIDLOCK IN PYRFORD"

The infrastructure is not adequate for purpose. How will we cope with a further 400+ car movements carrying children to and from school adding to the congestion we have now?
