Subject: Objection to proposal to develop 400+ houses on Green Belt land in Pyrford

Dear Jeni

I am writing to you to confirm my objection to the proposed housing develop on Green Belt land in Upshot Lane, Pyrford.

I would like to bring to your attention the following reasons for my objection:

Concerns raised by the local community about the Green Belt Review, via the Pyrford Neighbourhood forum, have been repulsed and ignored within the DPD.

The countryside around Pyrford is an asset the local area and County and will not benefit from building on this Greenbelt land, as it will remove a large area of open space and disrupt the natural vista.

The existing infrastructure is unable to support both the increased road traffic and population. Recent traffic surveys highlighted the traffic/parking problems when the Cooperative development planning was discussed. The green belt development is considerably larger than this and will increase the traffic congestion to unmanageable levels and increase the levels of pollution.

The primary school will be at capacity once the planned extension work is complete and does not have any additional land on which to extend further. The school is already over subscribed and must be able to support all of the Pyrford residents. The addition of further family housing in Pyrford will deny other residents in Pyrford school placements, which is unacceptable.

The borough have ignored the opinions of local residents and independent advisors which have recommended this planning is not appropriate for Pyrford.

I strongly objection to this proposal.
