I am writing to object to the proposals in reference to the release of the green Belt in Byfleet and surrounding areas.

Byfleet has already submitted a petition against this with 2,500 signatures which appears to have been ignored!

The infrastructure is already inadequate the roads especially Parvis Road are already gridlocked several times a day. The primary schools are over subscribed as are the Doctors, it is not unusual to wait nearly 3 weeks for a non urgent appointment! as Byfleet has no Medical Practice in the Village.

If the Green Belt is built upon here this removes most of Byfleet's Green Belt surely there are other areas in the Borough of Woking which have more land to spare than us especially when a lot of this land is prone to flooding.

We have lived here nearly 50 years and when we moved in Byfleet was a delightful Village but then the M25 was built and we lost a lot of Green Belt then and lots of trees which explains why locals stopped calling Murrays Lane Conker Arch.

Please please reconsider and leave Byfleets Green Belt to stay green
