I am objecting to the plans to build on Byfleet's Green Belt and the surrounding areas. Roads in this area are virtually at full capacity already in every direction from Byfleet during rush hour or whenever the M25 is slow as Byfleet becomes 'a rat run'.

A lot of our Green Belt land is frequently flooded, this gets worse every time more houses are built.

Byfleet has no medical facilities in the Village although we have a large number of elderly people living here either in accommodation for the elderly or their own homes, who if they don't drive have to rely on other people or a half hour bus service. Local schools are already over subscribed which then causes more traffic as parents have to deliver and collect their children to other schools.

If this Green Belt is taken then Byfleet has very little Green Belt left, a chunk of Green Belt was taken to build the M25, when the plans were changed to build that through Byfleet not near Cobham. I feel it's about time Byfleet was left as a Village before there are so many houses here, we will be designated a town, and will therefore expect many more amenities as we have so few now.

We have petitioned about this before and hope you take that into consideration
