I own a home in Ridge Close, Keepsake number 22 and I do wish to object to the proposals as set out in Planning document GB10, GB11, and GB14.

The sheer scale of these plans in one small area is not acceptable. It is inconceivable that what has been Green Belt in the 40 years I have lived in Ridge Close should be completely wiped out. The volume of houses suggested would not be in keeping with all other housing in the area of Mayford or Hook Heath. The roads in the area are not adequate, there is not enough schooling or medical facilities to serve such a huge growth and public transport in the area is on existent.

I would hope the borough Council will reject these plans.
