Subject: Objection to the Upshot Lane developments

Dear Ms Jackson,

I would like to submit a personal objection to the development of the Upshot Lane land in Pyrford. We are members of the community here and feel that the landscape of Surrey, already suburban is in danger of becoming urban if all the green spaces are slowly getting built on.

I understand the need for expansion and the pressures of a growing population but Pyrford already has an extremely over subscribed school and nurseries & clubs that have long waiting lists. The doctor's surgeries which 5 years ago had appointments when they were needed are now heavily booked up and difficult to both contact and get appointments. The roads of this area are already packed at peak times with often scores of people trying to get to London on the train, Guildford by road or on the local roads for school drop offs. I can't imagine how much worse it would be if these proposals go ahead. The hospitals have months of waiting time for non life threatening appointments and unless we propose to fully boost the infrastructure then the chaos of the development of Upshot Lane will cause damage to what is already a heavily populated area.
