I would like to officially register the Byfleet Petition and the Byfleet Questionnaire as evidence base in the current Public Consultation on the Site Allocations DPD.

The Byfleet Petition in 2013 was signed by some 2,500 residents and asked Woking Borough Council to preserve the Green Belt in Byfleet, especially the area surrounding Murrays Lane - which, at that time, was believed to be the only Green Belt land in Byfleet to be threatened. The Petition was presented to Woking Borough Council for safekeeping and receipts are available.

The Byfleet Questionnaire in 2014 was a multi page questionnaire with replies from some 1,600 residents where 89% of the replies stated that "Building on the Green Belt" was a concern and the Green Belt areas around Murrays Lane and the Queen's Head public house were both considered to be important aspects of Byfleet Village by over well 80% of residents. The questionnaires are available for inspection as and when required.
