

I would like to give you my views on the Woking Green Belt Review with regard to Pyrford where I live.

Pyrford Common (Parcel E)

The Common already has a robust boundary and there is therefore no need to create a new boundary which would undermine the integrity of the Common.

The Common (both sides of the road) is registered as a Village Green, in addition to being designated a Site of Nature Conservation Importance. These additional protections do not justify taking this precious resource out of the Green Belt, on the contrary they reinforce the need to retain this status.

Randall's Field (Parcel 9a)

With respect to Parcel 009a the methodology that the consultants apply to Parcel 9 leads them to the conclusion that Parcel 9 is not suitable for removal from the Green Belt. The site, it would appear, has been chosen simply for its attractiveness to developers since they (and not local residents) were consulted in the preparation of the report.

I object to these proposals. No land needs to be released from any of the Green Belt in Woking Borough . Development should be restricted to Brown Field sites only.
