I am writing to object to the proposed construction of over 400 new houses at upshot lane in pyrford, chiefly for the following three reasons:

firstly it would appear that woking borough council are substantially ignoring the recommendations of Peter Brett Associates, independent advisers appointed by the council themselves. why?

secondly, the area of the proposed development, particularly through the village and on the pyrford common road is extremely busy, especially between 8.00 and 9.00 in the mornings. the construction of over 400 new houses will increase congestion to unsafe levels.

thirdly perhaps wbc should concentrate their efforts on a smaller development providing more affordable homes for people who have grown up in pyrford but are unable to buy a home here themselves.
