I would like to register my opposition to the change of green belt boundary for the development of the upshot lane area proposed for 2027.

My reasons are:

The green belt is a precious commodity and once eroded it cannot be reclaimed and further opens the way for degradation in the future.

Pyrford has a defined a boundary which keeps its size as a village and this number of houses is disproportionate for the village and will change the character irreversibly.

The school and transport links by bus are already inadequate for the existing population of the village.

Finally the village character, roads and amenities will be seriously impacted by the volume of house proposed and associated cars on the narrow roads into and through the village. There have been a number of accidents over the years on the corner of Coldharbour Road which are as a result of speed and road layout.
