Dear Jeni

I am writing with regard to the potential development of 423 new homes in Upshot Lane, Pyrford. My wife, young son and I moved to Pyrford from London earlier this year. One of the principal attractions of the area for us was the green open space it offers, a significant portion of which is constituted by the two ancient fields that the council now proposes concreting over in order to build new houses. These fields are one of the few genuinely rural corners remaining in this borough, and developing this site will seriously diminish our natural environment. The Pyrford environs is already choked up with traffic at peak time, for instance turning out of Oakcroft Road towards both Woking and West Byfleet is a nightmare at most times of the day. Adding a potential further 800 new vehicles into the Pyrford area will only exacerbate these problems. I urge you not to build on these two fields and, instead, consider alternative brownfield development elsewhere within the borough. Thank you for taking the time to consider this communication.
