Dear Madam

We would like to officially object to the proposed planning application for 400+ houses in Pyrford and on the green belt. The green belt forms an essential part of our community and an important reason why people live here. Our objections are not only concerned with the applications on either side of Upshott Lane but moreover are concerned with the already dangerously overstretched infrastructure and services eg schools doctors sewage flooding and particularly the narrow roads which we fear will become gridlocked if even more traffic is forced upon them with the resulting pollution.

We are also particularly worried about the possible future planning along the Pyrford Road from a safety point of view. The junction of Hollybank Rd with Dodds Lane and Pyrford Rd are a nightmare now let alone having more traffic. When there is a problem on the M25 (which sadly is becoming more the norm than a rarity these days) the traffic queues well beyond Hollybank Rd as cars are trying to get into West Byfleet. It is a particularly busy road already without adding more traffic.

We feel that these proposals for large numbers of houses will ruin the environment and the ambiance of the village.

We hope you will consider our objections seriously.
