Subject: Objection: Pyrford housing proposal

Dear Ms Jackson

I am writing to object to the plans for 400+ new houses in Pyrford. The reasons are as follows;

- There is a growing traffic problem on ColdHarbour Road (next to proposed dwellings) during the school run. On several occasions I have experienced cars going onto the pavement in a fit of road rage putting pedestrians, mainly very young children at risk. Very recently a 3 year old child ended up in hospital with a broken collar bone due to traffic issues

- The local medical practices in West Byfleet can not currently cope with the level of demand. Frequently I am unable to get through on the phone to get an appointment (at the Parish Bridges practice) which is very problematic with poorly young children in the house. I would expect to wait several weeks to be seen for a non urgent appointment. The difficulty getting an appointment and the length of waiting time is discouraging people from going to the doctor (when they should) and the situation will only get worse

The local primary school is currently over subscribed which would inevitably mean that more local children will not be able to attend their local school. The school has just had to extend its wrap around childcare due to more working families in the area. The community would be put under huge pressure around schooling/childcare would not be offset by plans for new primary schools further afield.

I strongly object to the plans given its significant impact on the local community and the considerable pressure on local services.
