I was born in Woking in 1934 and I have seen many changes to Woking in that time and I have to say that, mainly on the whole, these have been for the better. I have regular visitors from overseas and feel proud to take them around Woking to see how the town has developed.

THIS IS BECAUSE THE CHANGES HAVE BEEN FOR THE BENEFIT OF THOSE LIVING IN THE TOWN AND THE SURROUNDING AREA.

I was fortunate to move into Mayford in 1976 and have been very happy with the wonderful village life available yet being only a few miles away from the town centres of Woking and Guildford. The green belt surrounding Mayford keeps us apart from these two main towns yet we are in a short distance from the benefits of town life when we need it.

There are regular changes in the people living in Mayford and many of these new arrivals drop into the village way of life without any problems to them or the existing villagers.
