

## Woking 2027 DPD Consultation

Dear Sirs

As land owners and residents in Mayford since 1975, we have long valued its character. We are therefore now writing to formally record our objections to the Woking 2027 planning proposals, in particular the housing proposals for sites GB8, GB9, GB10, GB11 and GB14 which will seriously impact the village.

At the recent meeting in Mayford Village Hall, the figures provided by Mr Amoako revealed that almost all of the Green Belt incursions deemed necessary to meet Woking's housing targets were concentrated in Mayford – 569 houses. Why all in this small village ?

The community infrastructure is not there to support such an expansion in population.

The consequences of the additional traffic to shops, work and railway stations do not appear to have been part of Woking's considerations but certainly should have been :-

The Egley Road is already congested and will be more so with the building of the Hoe Valley School.

Two of the other approach roads that will be affected are restricted with traffic-light controlled railway bridges. If these plans go ahead there will be gridlock.

Your present plans will destroy the nature of Mayford as an historic village separate from Woking and embedded in the Green Belt.

We fully support the representations of the Mayford Village Society.

Please reconsider your plans.
