Dear Jeni

My family and I have lived at 12 Weston Way, Pyrford, Woking, SURREY, GU22 8RW for over 20 years now. We value the village feel that exists in Pyrford and our proximity to open fields and magnificent views.

We are, however, concerned about the potential for development of two separate fields on the outskirts of Pyrford. The basis for this objection includes:

- 1) Loss of greenbelt and heritage views from the Pyrford escarpment
- 2) 50 % of the development goes against the recommendation of the council's own consultants; and
- 3) There is already a lack of infrastructure, particularly healthcare facilities, schools and roads and this will be compounded by the potential development on green-belt.

The roads in and around Pyrford, West Byfleet and through the countryside to Ripley are already overcrowded, often jammed and increasingly dangerous for cyclists. It is this situation that is alarming to us as residents of Pyrford.

We have followed and participated in the Pyrford Neighbourhood Forum Consultation and so understand the strength of feeling amongst the residents regarding this development.

I hope that you will consider not only the wishes of Pyrford residents but also consider the resulting road chaos that will ensue.

We look forward to common sense prevailing.
