Dear Ms Jackson

I understand from the Pyrford Neighbourhood Forum and also the Byfleet, West Byfleet and Pyrford Resident's Association, that Woking Borough council is proposing to release Green Belt land with a view to building over 400 new houses in the the Pyrford area, namely 223 dwellings in the Lovelace Drive area and 200 in the Aviary road area.

I would be very grateful if you would note my objections as I am very much against this proposal on several grounds:

- 1). The whole purpose of the protection of Green Belt is that England doesn't become completely concreted over
- 2). To start chipping away at Green Belt land is the thin end of the wedge. **And politicians are actually surprised that the public don't trust them.**
- 3). Woking borough Council should not be trying to attract more people into this area when it is already having problems coping with overcrowding. I have to wait three weeks now for a doctor's appointment. Goodness knows how long one would have to wait to see a GP with over 400 extra families moving in. No doubt this proposal would also adversely affect schools in the area and other services
- 4). Residential roads would become more dangerous and cause more problems with so many extra cars .
- 5). And one only has to turn on the garden hose to be aware that the Water company has difficulty coping now in hot weather let alone with so many extra families.
