Subject: Development Plans

I am writing to raise my serious objections to the proposed development plans in West Byfleet and Pyrford.

How are you going to address the problem of the massive influx of people into such a small area? West Byfleet already has a major traffic problem in the morning and evening rush hours, not counting the parent school parking in Oakcroft Road and Sheerwater Road when dropping/collecting children for the Marist School. The Health Centre already has in excess of 30,000 patients to contend with. I foresee total lock down for months and months for existing residents, if and when the proposed building work starts, not to mention the laying of sewerage pipes, electricity, gas, telephone cabling etc.

I wrote to Jonathan Lord last year regarding the poor condition of the Parvis Road and Old Woking Road, the extra volume of traffic will result in even more road problems.

I would also like to know who the intended new houses are for and why should we be allowing traveller pitches?

My husband and I have lived in Pyrford and West Byfleet for 20 years and we chose this part of Surrey because of the excellent facilities offered for medical, shopping, train services and general road travel. This is certainly going to change and in our opinion definitely not for the better.
