I am writing to register my objections regarding the proposed development at Upshott Lane in Pyrford.

I really cannot understand how the local village of Pyrford and surrounding villages will cope with the proposed extra houses and cars that will be added to an increasingly busy village.

We have lived in the village for over 12 years and in that time have seen the traffic increase around the local roads, the area of Lincoln Drive is already used as a cut through during rush hour and there have been a number of serious road traffic accidents, including one right outside the local primary school.

The local school is full to capacity and could not accommodate one of my sons, he had to attend a school in another village 10 minutes away.
