As a Byfleet resident of more than 45 years, I am very concerned with the way the village's green belt land is shrinking. Byfleet's green belt is tiny compared with other parts of Woking. Mayford, Pyrford etc. I am appalled that Woking Council has not found it necessary to publicise their proposals and if it wasn't for Facebook no one at all would know about it. I cannot believe that Woking Council would consider any further building along the A245 road. This road is already at a standstill every day in the morning and from about 4 pm onwards. Any additional building along this road would be crazy. Our village is used as a "rat run" every day when frustrated drivers race down the slip road from the A245 take a short cut through and out the other side. The proposed housing estate at Murrays Lane/Rectory Lane is on a plot of land that is usually flooded every year. Having been a victim of flooding any further building would increase the risk of it re-occurring. Health facilities in Byfleet do not exist, we are expected to join the queue of traffic up the A245
