My objections to the green belt release are

Parvis road and Byfleet road are already congested, particularly if there is an accident on the M 25, where will another 1000 plus cars go??

Schools are already oversubscribed, the medical centre would not be able to cope.

Local roads would not be adequate, or the existing drainage system

Flooding is already an issue and would be more so if this building went ahead.

Ashford and St Peter's hospital is already failing with the time waiting for A + E (4 hours plus) this would probably become longer!!

This removes most of the local green belt, while 98% of Woking's is preserved. Ours must be preserved, other land is available.

The Byfleet petition with some 2,500 names has been ignored.
