**Subject:** Green Belt development proposals

My wife and I, residents in Pyrford for over 46 years, wish to register our objections to the Woking WBC proposals for new housing developments especially the encroachment of green belt land in Pyrford.

The council has failed to take into account and arbitrarily rejected the site representations made by PFN.

With the enlargement of Pyrford school already approved to take account of existing pupil numbers substantial additional changes to the local infrastructure would be necessary, including new roads, water, sewage and shopping facilities.

This would totally change the character of the village and add to the already dangerous road congestion.

It would in effect combine Pyrford within the boundary of Woking and obliterate the separateness of the existing community.

We are NOT NIMBY'S and appreciate that steps must be taken to increase the overall housing stock, but this is demonstrably not the right way and local voices must be heard.
