I have lived in Pyrford for 18 years having moved from London to bring my children up in a small, beautiful community where they could feel safe and also not have to travel far to their local school and park. By building over 400 houses you will be ruining the surrounding area as well as break up our community.

When I first moved into the area I was able to get a doctors appointment the same day I asked. Now I have to wait nearly a month. Just imagine how long I will have to wait when hundreds more people move here.
