Dear Jeni,

Can you please advise on the process to formally object to the proposed development on Pyrford greenbelt?

While I fully understand the need to provide additional housing in our ever increasingly crowded country, I am alarmed at this development for two reasons:

- Pyrford is a village. The addition of another 400 houses plus the necessary infrastructure to support it (roads, shops, schools, doctors, etc., etc.) will destroy Pyrford as we know it and create a town. While Pyrford is somewhat less 'sleepy' than it was when I first moved here at the age of 6, it is still very much a quintessentially village lifestyle.
- There are significant planning restrictions in this area for a reason. It is a beautiful part of the world steeped in history and supports numerous indigenous wildlife. It would be a crime to destroy this environment when there are significant urbanised areas around Woking that could be redeveloped without the impact to Surrey's beautiful environment.

Please help us protect this beautiful part of the Woking area.

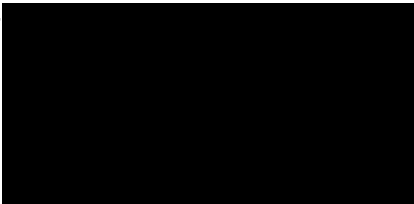
