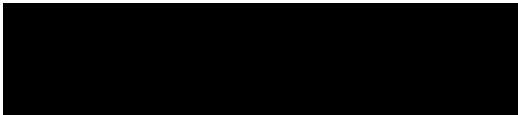

Re: Site Allocations Developments Plan Document

I strongly object to any more development in Byfleet, over the years we have had our fair share, in fact more than our fair share of developments and we are at saturation point and the fact now is the Green Belt is now under threat. If the Green Belt is to be taken away we will have no open space at all, and our Village will be no more.

- 1) The A245 runs through the middle of the Village and gets congested now, when there is a problem on the M25 and A3 Byfleet becomes completely gridlocked, if further development takes place the A245 will be gridlocked permanently.
- 2) The infrastructure needs to be in place before any further developments are considered.
- 3) Flooding is a major issue in and around Byfleet Village and until all of the above mentioned are addressed no further development should be considered.
