Objection to building 400+ houses in Pyrford

Dear Madam,

I am writing to you in your capacity as Head of Planning at Woking Borough Council to object to the proposed building of 400+ houses on greenbelt land in Pyrford adjacent to Lovelace Drive and Aviary Road. As a resident of Pyrford for over 25 years, I feel very strongly about preserving the rural nature and status of our village. Vehicle access along Upshot Lane is already overloaded for this narrow single carriageway thoroughfare to our village and would clearly become heavily overloaded with the additional 800 cars we could anticipate from 400 houses.

Further examples of the strain placed upon local community by this housing development include;

- The adjacent Coldharbour Road is wholly inadequate in accommodating vehicles during the school run to Pyrford Primary and causes major disruption to vehicular access at that time.
- An increase in the population would further burden an already overstretched Health Centre in West Byfleet and St Peters hospital.
- Past experience in summoning the police to the scene of a break-in in my street, demonstrates that our local police force are clearly over-stretched in enforcing the law within the existing community, without the added burden this development would bring.

It is therefore apparent that a local building development of this size in the Pyrford area would place intolerable strain upon the infrastructure of our rural community and I therefore lodge this formal complaint against the plan.
