I am Tim Franklin and have lived within Mayford for 40 years. I have been actively engaged in the Village for at least 35 years and was Secretary to the Management Committee when we needed to embark on rebuilding the old wooden Hall.

Much involvement was received from many local residents, particularly from those living on Saunders Lane. During that engagement I became aware of the number of residents who had lived their lives in 'The Lane'. Mayford is a very close knit Village, with a good network of people who volunteer help when it is needed.

I am now 85 years of age and have been attracted to the area because of the benefits afforded by the Green Belt status, if the proposed change to the boundary is granted, the increase in the traffic density cannot be accepted within the current road system.

I therefore strongly object to the level of development being proposed for Saunders lane. This development will destroy the current village atmosphere we currently enjoy and the increased traffic (created as a direct result of these proposals) is unacceptable.

I know my views are shared amongst many of my neighbours and I wish my objections to be registered.
