I wish to register my objection to the proposal to build more than 400 new homes on the land either side of Upshot Lane.

This is a very ill conceived plan. There will be others who can speak more knowledgeably than me on the various issues of impact but I would like you to consider the following:

There simply is insufficient infrastructure around this area to support such a development. The roads around this area are narrow and already busy. In particular the additional traffic on the road into Ripley would create a dangerous bottleneck with Ripley High Street which is already frequently congested.

There are an inadequate number of school, medical, dental, care facilities in this area already.

This proposal would depreciate this area significantly. It is a green lung for Woking and Pyrford residents enabling them to get away from the built up areas and enjoy recreational facilities e.g. Walking, running, playing, etc.

Woking Borough Council are in danger of spoiling Woking and it's environment if they adopt this scheme to ruin the surrounding area. Whilst appreciating the need to find additional accommodation this must be done with due care to the existing houses and facilities or else you are at risk of turning this into an area where people simply do not want to live any longer.

I urge to reconsider this scheme and reject the proposal to build on these two fields.
