Sir, I would like to make my views known on several of the planning applications currently being reviewed.

### GB7

- **Address:** Ten Acre Farm, Smarts Heath Road, Mayford, GU22 0NP
- **Proposed Use:** Up to 12 Traveller pitches
- **Timing:** Between 2016 and 2027

Response: This is totally disproportionate to the requirements of the area. There are already two large traveller sites on Burdenshot road.

### GB8

- **Address:** Nursery land adjacent to Egley Road, Mayford, GU22 0PL
- **Proposed Use:** Residential including Affordable Housing, recreational/open space and education,
- **Timing:** Between 2022 and 2027]
- You will be aware that a new school is already proposed for this site **now**.

Just the new school is going to cause untold chaos on the Egley Road. Traffic often queues into Woking from the Mayford roundabout. If the school must go ahead it is imperative that we protect the remaining green belt between Woking and Guildford

### GB9

- **Address:** Woking Garden Centre, Egley Road, Mayford, Woking, GU22 0NH
- **Proposed Use:** To meet long term development needs
- **Timing:** Safeguarded to between 2027 and 2040

As above, we need this as green belt to keep Woking and Guildford separate

### GB10

- **Address:** Land to the North East of Saunders Lane, between Saunders Lane and Hook Hill Lane, Mayford, GU22 0NN
- **Proposed Use:** To meet long term development needs
- **Timing:** Safeguarded to between 2027 and 2040

This is a fabulous parcel of land used by many for recreational walks. Please don't ruin it

### GB11

- **Address:** Land to the North West of Saunders Lane, Mayford, GU22 0NN
- **Proposed Use:** To meet long term development needs
- **Timing:** Safeguarded to between 2027 and 2040

Again please safeguard this land and keep it in the green belt

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
