I strongly oppose the WBC's plans to build this large amount of houses and a school in this area.

Out of the 22 available sites around Woking, to choose 2 sites in West Byfleet, Broadoaks and West Hall, total approx. 750 houses plus a school, with traffic having to use the Parvic road for both sites, is bad planning indeed.

Parvic road at the moment is gridlocked as it is at rush hours. To propose only to build a roundabout is almost laughable.

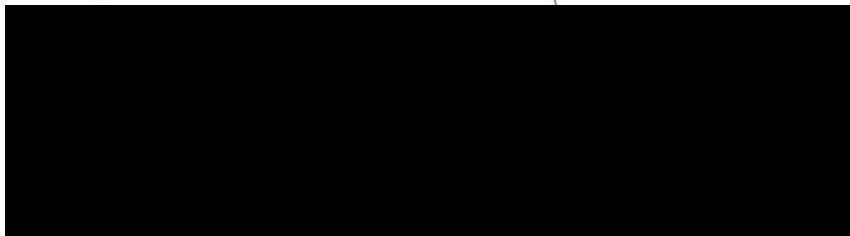
Then, on top of this, an additional 643 houses in Byfleet and Pyrford!!!

In short, I oppose these plans because of the following points:

- - traffic on Parvis Road and our narrow local roads (they will all be gridlocked)
- - Access to Healthcare
- - Parking in the centre of West Byfleet
- - Total loss of Green Belt sites in West Byfleet
- - localised flooding
- - capacity of sewerage system
