I have seen the proposed plans and strongly object. I live on Byfleet and am all too aware of how busy the roads can be, in particular Parvis Road. Cars are also tending to cut through Byfleet village itself to try and get further up Parvis road. This is causing huge problems for villagers and the village is gridlocked, as is Parvis road nearly every morning and evening. The car pollution is also quite something.
