Dear Jeni,

I am writing regarding the proposed build of 400 properties in Upshot Lane and wanted to highlight some issues that this development will bring.

Firstly and possibly the most key issue is the destruction of the landscape and green belt in and around Pyrford. I have not seen any proposals for the development of any brown field sites, and there are plenty in the borough.

Secondly, the infrastructure will not be capable of delivering services to a further 1000+ people which includes roads (which are busy enough), doctors (3 weeks to receive an appointment in West Byfleet) and the train service (West Byfleet train station car park is full daily).

I strongly believe that there are other sites worthy of consideration which are probably more expensive to develop before we remove the green belt.
