I write to strongly object to the proposals to build a large number of houses on either side of Upshot Lane:

Pyrford is relatively unspoilt countryside and is a strong asset to the borough. It has narrow country lanes that can only just cope with the current traffic that passes through at present. If these houses were to be built it would be a disaster with the increased traffic. We do not have the facilities or infrastructure to cope with this amount of new housing. It would totally spoil the village of Pyrford. We do not want to become just another suburb of Woking. The village feel and surrounding countryside is one of the main reasons I came to live in Pyrford. There are a lot of elderly residents here and we should take into account the effect this would have on them.
