Dear Jeni,

My wife and family are residents of Pyrford, Woking and we are writing to you with regards to the proposed Upshot Lane development.

I was persuaded to have our family home in Pyrford by my wife who has grown up in and around the area. We love the village feel to the area and as we are an active family, with small children, enjoy the fact there is plenty of open space and natural landscape for the children.

Whilst we understand the need for additional housing given increasing population, particularly in the South East, we feel very strongly that the number of houses proposed is significantly too high for the area.

Levels of congestion around the area are already very high due to population density and the narrow roads which surround the area. In addition, local infrastructure particularly the local schools and obviously Pyrford Primary, are already overstretched. As we have 2 young children, there is already not enough pre-school provision and one has just closed it's doors (Flying Start Nursery).

In summary, whilst additional housing/affordable/homes for the elderly are required, we feel the proposed level of new houses is significantly too high for the area which is effectively a large village with a strong community feel which we would like to keep.
