Re: Woking 2027 DPD Consultation and in particular to site references:

GB10 (Land to the north east of Saunders Lane, between Saunders Lane and Hook Hill Lane, Mayford GU22 0NN)

GB11 (Land to the north west of Saunders Lane, Mayford, GU22 0NN)

GB14(Land adjacent to Hook Hill Lane, Hook Heath GU22 0PS)

As a resident of Hook Heath I am writing to register my objection to the removal of areas GB 10, GB 11 and GB 14 from the Green Belt and to proposals to build houses on parcels GB 10 and GB 11 post 2027.

My reasons for objecting are:

1. Transport:

a) Local roads are very overcrowded during the rush hour times. Egley Road, in particular, is heavily congested with cars going to Woking station and the town centre. With more housing and the associated schools, shops etc. the situation can only become worse.

b) There are few local bus routes, so residents of the proposed new developments will be isolated unless they have a car.

2. Urban Sprawl:

If the green belt is used for development we will end up with an enormous urban area with few open spaces. Not only Mayford and Woking but eventually Woking and Guildford..... Heaven forbid!
This would change the whole character of this beautiful area of the south-east.
