**Subject:** Green Land in Pyrford

We wish to record our objections to the land on either side of Upshot Lane being redesignated from green belt, thereby allowing the building of 400+ houses.

- Pyrford's character is that of a village and if such a large development were to be allowed, the character of the village would change and Pyrford would become an extension of West Byfleet and Woking.
- The increase in traffic from West Byfleet to Woking, through Pyrford, and from Ripley would cause significant problems in that Upshot Lane is narrow at present and would need to be widened to cope with additional traffic. Equally Pyrford Common Road would have further traffic, depending on where access from Pyrford Common Road would be.
- The school at Pyrford is at capacity, so where are the children who will live in the new houses go to school?
- The Health Centre at West Byfleet is already overstretched and further families would increase this problem.
- If it is envisaged that the Arbor will be included in this site, the uniformed organisations and other clubs using it as their headquarters would lose their meeting place.
- Therefore the entire infrastructure of Pyrford would require extensive rethinking.

The proposed site is far from ideal for development and within the Woking boundary there are far more suitable sites. It would be a tragedy if Pyrford were to lose this green belt land.
