With reference to the proposed planning application for over 400 new houses I am writing to you to express my very strong objections.

As a resident of Pyrford for 28 years I have many reasons for voicing my objections.

One of the reasons for moving to the area was the perfect mix of village and countryside which I feel is now being eroded, the new proposals will make expanding the village worse.

The traffic is already very congested and I feel the building of this amount of housing will make it worse with the access on Upshott Lane/ Pyrford Common Road and locally.

It would also have an effect on public footpaths, trees, hedging, all the things that make Pyrfords charm and character what it is today.

I have also serious concerns about Pyrfords infrastructure ie pre school / nursery and schooling which I understand is at full capacity.
