To whom it may concern,

As a Pyrford resident I am somewhat surprised and of course disappointed by this proposal and must object.

Obviously the importance of maintaining the Green character of the area is essential, but as a local I am also very familiar with the pressure on local roads especially at peak times.

Examples of this to include:

Anyone who witnesses the congestion from Old Woking Road into Sheerwater Road or alternatively through into West Byfleet would question how the roads could cope with the increased traffic and frankly I don't believe they can.

Additionally traffic flow increase past schools will be significant, the proposed layout will involve many vehicles turning across the traffic, both very significant safety issues, coupled with the inevitable increase of "rat runs" through low speed residential areas.

Study of maps demonstrates how that will happen.

In summary, as well as objecting environmentally, I also object logistically to the proposal as well as being concerned about the safety of members of the community.
