Dear Sirs

I am contacting you with regard to the council's proposal to remove a sizable proportion of Mayford from the Green Belt in 2027.

Green Belt was designated to protect areas of special interest, and to form a barrier between towns ie Woking & villages ie Mayford. Having lived in the area for the past 40 years I am concerned that what we valued especially the conservation areas of Prey Heath & Smarts Heath will be seriously comprised if not destroyed.

Mayford is essentially a rural community. The roads (lanes)

are so narrow in parts that vehicles have to stop to allow others to pass. There are 3 single line bridges in the village - 2 with traffic lights and many roads without pavement. Any development will put severe strain on the existing infrastructure. The impact will be felt not only in Mayford, Hook Heath & Sutton Green but also in Egky Road which already suffers from congestion ~~from~~ at peak times. (This is going to be exacerbated by the building of the new school)

I understand that these plans are for 2027, but once it is known that the land is eventually to be released from Green Belt pressure will come from many quarters to bring that date forward.

I beg you to reconsider the decision to release this land from Green Belt in 2027
