Subject: Upshot Lane Housing Plans

Hello.

We live on Lower Pyrford Road, between junction with Lock Lane and Elvedon Close and are deeply concerned with the Housing plan for Upshot Lane, on two specific grounds.

a) vehicular access to the area is already very limited. There are three main road accesses to the Upshot Lane area. The junction of Pyrford Common Road and Old Woking Road. The junction of Coldharbour Road and Old Woking Lane, And over the bridges and through Ripley. All these roads are very highly congested already at peak periods.

b) the water table level and passage of surface water in Lower Pyrford Road and Warren Lane area is already very sensitive to activity in the fields. Reduction of natural drainage process in the fields planned for the Housing Plan will substantially make this worse. Several houses in our area have been flooded in the past.
