Good Afternoon

I would like to object strongly to the proposals to build on Green Belt Land.

The Green Belt must be preserved, there is other land available. The Parvis Road (A245) will become unusable, and Byfleet will be gridlocked.

The current infrastructure provision (ie for education, health, drains, roads etc) is already inadequate and must be rectified BEFORE any developments. Much of Byfleet and the proposed area has already been flooded or is in danger of flooding.

This removes most of the local Green Belt, while 98% of Woking's Green Belt is preserved.

The Byfleet Petition with some 2,500 names has been ignored.

It is bad enough when there is a problem on the M25 all the traffic detours through Byfleet, West Byfleet and New Haw which is a nightmare.

It would be a crying shame if this proposal was to go ahead.
