I wish to object to the above release of Green Belt Land and associated areas as outlined in the proposals because of the following :

1. There is no infrastructure to support any further development. The main road (A 245) is more than oversubscribed currently. Reports clearly show this
2. Other infrastructure includes, schooling, hospitals and medical centres. The medical centre used by most residents in Byfleet and West Byfleet has a waiting time of between 21 to 28 days for a routine Doctors appointment.
3. During the Winter of 2012/2013 Byfleet was featured on the National News networks showing the extensive flooding on the Floodplains which is part of the allocated housing areas up for development. The Village has 3 areas of roads and pavements which regularly flood with the slightest rainfall putting pedestrians and motorists at risk. Flooding and drains are a major problem.
4. The residents of Byfleet signed a petition of over 2500 named persons who object to these proposals has this been ignored ?
5. The Byfleet Village has very little Green Belt left and this development would erode this tiny resource even more, not fair at all
