In fact we would encourage re-using existing sites but please leave the green ones alone.

We love our bike rides past this green area and across to the golf course, its a lovely walk/ride. Its the reason we moved here. Housing will spoil and restrict this.

Finally, the traffic has become so bad, we cannot get out of Pyrford woods in the morning and it takes 30 mins to queue to the M25 on weekdays. More cars is not what we need - its a nightmare. Old Woking Rd, Parvis Road, Ripley (and the list goes on) our area is gridlock - try and get out to work in the morning from our house - if you are not out by 7am you have had it.
