Dear Sir/Madam,

We have read the above planning documents and strongly object to the proposals for 420+ houses to be built on greenbelt land either side of Upshott Lane.

The fields concerned represent a convenient and easy target for Woking Council and we find the superficiality of the planning rationale breathtaking.

Using your terminology, the area concerned already represents a defensible greenbelt boundary.

Building 420+ houses (many more if the density of 40 dph alluded to is adopted), will :-

- a) adversely affect the character of the area and destroy the village atmosphere of Pyrford forever and
- b) place an impossible strain on the local infrastructure (schools, medical services, roads, transport etc., and on local services at Marshall Parade, Pyrford and West Byfleet which are already stretched.

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
