I would like you to register my objection to the number of houses proposed to be built on the land surrounding Byfleet and West Byfleet once the land has been released.

This is on the grounds of lack of road infrastructure to take the increased number of cars, lack of primary and secondary school spaces available, and lack of infrastructure to support the houses.

Currently, the roads surrounding Byfleet and West Byfleet are gridlocked from 4pm until 6pm on weekdays. Particularly Old Woking Road, Parvis Road, Oyster Lane, Byfleet Road - those surrounding Brooklands. This has already been exacerbated by the introduction of the traffic lights outside the Marist School.

I would also like to register my objection to the size of the school being proposed at Broadoaks. The traffic will stand still for hours if a school of the size being proposed goes ahead with its related morning and afternoon traffic. Possibly 500 more cars? Impossible!

We would consider moving from the area if we cannot travel freely within it!
