

Green belt releases in Byfleet

Having looked at your plans for site allocations to build more housing in Byfleet you appear to have gone unerringly for areas that flood. We have enough problems with flooding in the village without adding to the difficulties.

The infrastructure in the village is inadequate for current needs. The drains on the roads are not capable of dealing with even heavy rain leading to flooding on a number of places on the Parvis Road and Oyster Lane.

We have no health facilities in the village and have to travel to West Byfleet where waits to be seen are significant. The large increase in population will only exacerbate the situation.

The Parvis Road is a traffic nightmare already and can only get worse. One only has to think of the increased traffic tailbacks that will occur from 3rd of August as work commences on laying gas pipes in the Old Woking Road.

There is a significant amount of Green belt within the borough but the removal has not been allocated equitably with the vast preponderance of it the new building being pushed out to the eastern edges of the borough.
